The Nuremberg Christkindlesmarkt



The Nuremberg Christkindlesmarkt

The Nuremberg Christkindlesmarkt traditionally takes place in the heart of the Old Town on the Main Market Square. The enticing aroma of gingerbread, mulled wine and grilled sausages fills the air at the Nuremberg Christkindlesmarkt.

First mentioned in 1628, its roots probably go back to the time of the Reformation, when the tradition of giving children presents at Christmas evolved. Since then, traditional wares such as handmade Christmas decorations, "Rauschgoldengel" (gold foil angels) and prune men as well as culinary delights have been offered in more than 160 wooden booths with red and white roofs. Take a stroll through the festively lighted lanes and discover the enchantment of this magical atmosphere.

The Nuremberg Christkind

The Christkind is the symbol of Christmas in Nuremberg. With its blond curly hair, wearing a golden crown and gold-and-white gown, it traditionally opens its market with a prologue on the Friday before the first Sunday in Advent. Appearances at the Christkindlesmarkt, the Children's Christmas Market and the „Sternenhaus“ are part of its regular schedule along with visits to charitable organizations. Nuremberg selects a new Christkind for this heavenly office every two years.

The Christkind opens its Market



The prologue which the Nuremberg Christkind recites every year at the opening of the Christkindlesmarkt was written in 1948 by Friedrich Bröger. He was the principal dramaturg of the theater and son of the Nuremberg workers' poet Karl Bröger. The text has been adapted a number of times.

You men and women, who once yourselves were children,
You little ones, life's journey just beginning,
Each and all, who troubled tomorrow, are full of cheer today,
Pray listen to what Christkind has come to say!

Every year, four weeks before the time,
To decorate the Christmas tree, to celebrate the season,
Appears upon this square, your forebears knew it too,
What you here see, called Christkindlesmarkt by you,
This little town within the town, of wood and cloth made,
Whose short-lived splendor so fleeting seems to be,
And yet it is eternal. My market shall forever young remain.
As long as Nuremberg stands, and the memory of that market's fame.

For Nuremberg is both old and young at once,
The many features of its countenance beyond all count.
Here this noble square. But now adjoining it,
The tall buildings of today, the factories of the modern world
The new city of so much green. And yet, you men and women true
It will remain forever the Nuremberg that is you.

Now as the old year ends there comes the day,
When wishes can be made and presents given,
When the market shines forth far and wide,
With decorations, and crystal balls, and blessed Christmastide
This you may not forget, you men and women, heed my word,
He who has all needs nothing more,
There are the children of this world and poor,
Who know the best what giving's for.

You men and women, who once yourselves were children,
Be them again today, happy as children be,
And now the Christkind to its market calls,
And all who come are truly welcome.

Sustainability at the Christkindlesmarkt

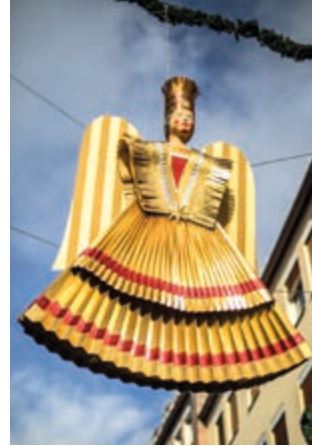
The Nuremberg Christkindlesmarkt is also active in the topic of sustainability. Regional supply is important and organic and homemade products are valued. A variety of measures are being implemented step by step to protect the environment and climate.



- ◆ To keep waste at a minimum, all beverage stalls at the market work with a universal reusable cup system with the same mugs at each booth. The Christkindlesmarkt was the first in Germany to implement this deposit system.
- ◆ The lights at the Christkindlesmarkt are as environmentally friendly as possible. All the holiday illumination comes from LED lights which are lit by 100% ecological power from the region.
- ◆ For the market booths themselves, protecting resources plays an important role. The stalls are all made of regional spruce and are repaired and reused year for year. You can even walk past stands that still date back in part to 1890.

Gold Foil Angels

It glitters and glistens, traditionally has no arms, is the quintessence of the Nuremberg Christkindlesmarkt and can be found here in all sizes – the Nuremberg gold foil angel.



According to legend, a Nuremberg doll maker made it for his sick daughter. An origin in the 16th century is more likely:

At that time, the thinly beaten brass used to make them was called "Rauschgold", because of the whispering sound it made.



Tip: Find the stands selling prune men and "Rauschgoldengel" on the market map!

The World of the Prune Men

Zwetschenmännle – the well loved figures made of prunes – have been sold at the Christkindlesmarkt for decades. More than 350 different figures are available. The figures are 9 to 22 centimeters high and are an illustrious company on the shelves of the stalls where they're sold.

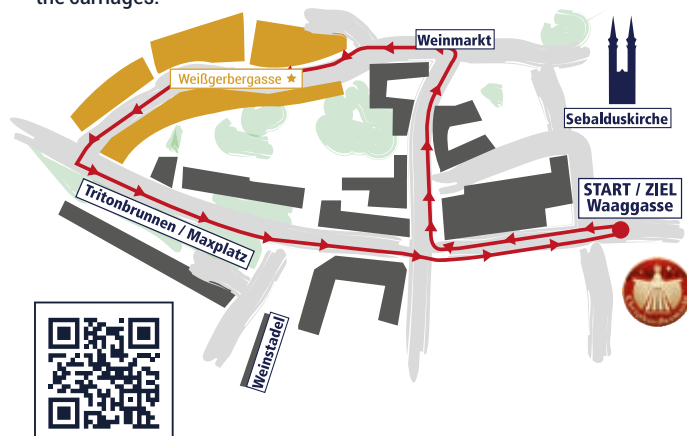


Nostalgic Post Coach Rides

Specialties at the Christkindlesmarkt



Nuremberg, like no other city in Germany, stands for culinary delicacies. While gingerbread is at its peak during the Christmas season, the finger-sized grilled sausages are eaten all year long. Equally worth trying is a crackling pork shoulder (Schäuferle) with a dumpling (Kloß) or a Franconian carp (Karpfen). A glass of Franconian wine or a cool beer from a private Franconian owned brewery are an enjoyable pairing with the regional specialties.



But not only traditional Franconian cuisine finds its way to your plate in Nuremberg. Gourmet establishments and restaurants with star ratings treat their guests to innovative dishes and exceptional food combinations. Fresh regional products are the norm, mostly sourced from the local market gardens of Knoblauchsland. In restaurants and on the market, a wide range of vegetarian and vegan food is offered along with the best quality organic products. No wonder, because Nuremberg is an organic metropolis.

Tasty and Decorative

It looks back on a long tradition and – like mulled wine – is indelibly linked with Christmas: Nuremberg gingerbread. Thanks to the trading links of its cosmopolitan merchants, the city developed early on into a gingerbread capital, for the gingerbread makers were continually supplied with almonds, cinnamon and other spices. The forest around Nuremberg also helped furnish an essential component – natural honey. Today this specialty, which under EU law can be produced only within the city limits, is found in round as well as square shapes, coated with chocolate or a sugar icing or plain with almonds.



Be sure not to miss the Nuremberg anise-flavored cookie with an embossed design, also called a "Springerle" or "Reiterle". It is made of eggs, flour and fine sugar, and produced by pressing the dough into a mold. This delicious and decorative treat is usually hung on the Christmas tree and later eaten.

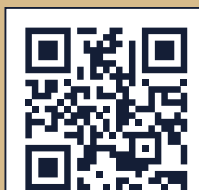

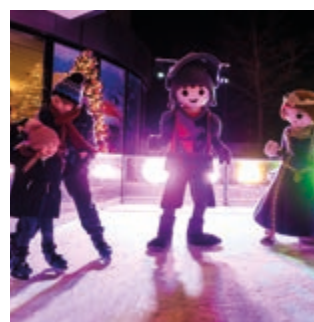
