TOP SIGHTSEEING HIGHLIGHTS

- 01 **Imperial Castle** – one of the most important fortified imperial palaces of the Old Holy Roman Empire – kaiserburg-nuernberg.de
- 02 **Albrecht Dürer's House** – only existing home of an artist from the 15th century in northern Europe today – museums.nuernberg.de
- 03 **Germanisches Nationalmuseum** – the largest cultural-historical museum in the German-speaking world – gnm.de
- 04 **Memorium Nuremberg Trials** – where world history was written – museums.nuernberg.de
- 05 **Documentation Centre** – located on the former Nazi Party Rally grounds – museums.nuernberg.de

CITY'S HISTORY

- ★ Nuremberg was first mentioned in 1050
- ★ Germany's most important artist of the Middle Ages, Albrecht Dürer lived and worked here
- ★ In 1835 the first German railway was opened between Nuremberg and Fürth, this was the beginning of industrialization
- ★ From 1945 to 1949 the Intl. Military Tribunal against leaders of the Nazi Regime took place in Nuremberg



DID YOU KNOW THAT ...

- ★ the Nuremberg Bratwurst is smaller than most of the others? Because the city's gates were locked at night during the Middle Ages, the innkeepers found it very practical to have sausages small enough to pass through the keyhole to serve their guests in the evening.



TOP DAY EXCURSIONS




- 01 **Bamberg** (43 miles from Nuremberg) – UNESCO World Heritage Site
- 02 **Rothenburg o.d. Tauber** (50 miles from Nuremberg) – 2 miles medieval city wall, 40 towers
- 03 **Regensburg** (62 miles from Nuremberg) – UNESCO World Heritage Site
- 04 **Würzburg** (62 miles from Nuremberg) – UNESCO World Heritage Site
- 05 **Bayreuth** (50 miles from Nuremberg) – home of Richard Wagner and the world-renowned "Richard Wagner Festival" and The Margravian Opera House (UNESCO World Heritage Site)
