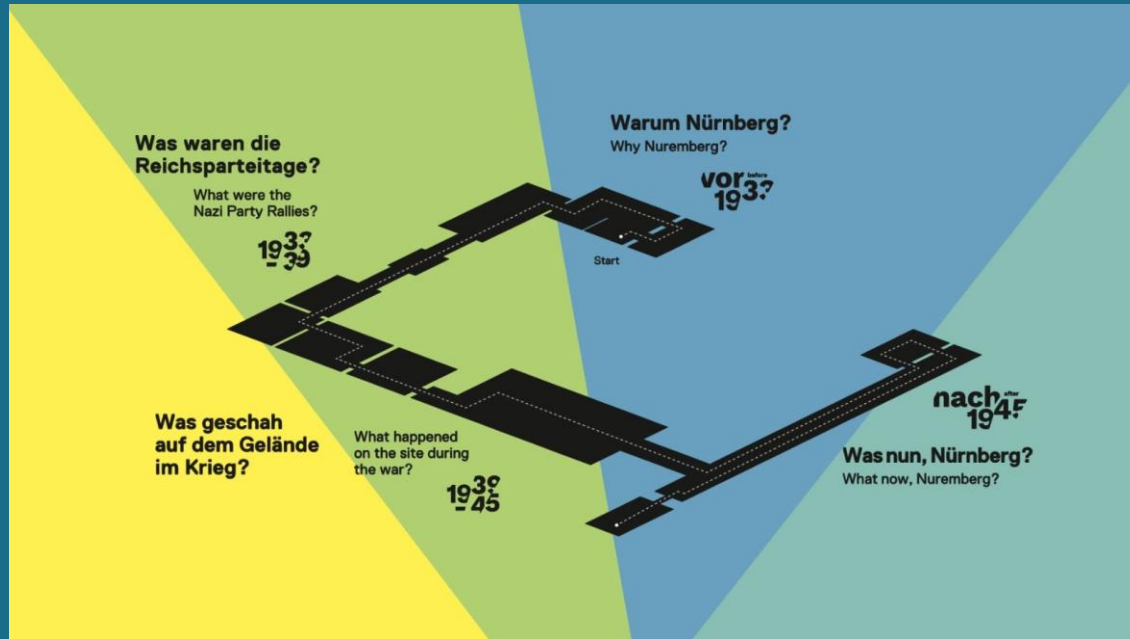
Future of the Former Nazi Party Rally Grounds

In the coming years, the **former Nazi Party Rally Grounds** will be reshaped into a place of remembrance and culture. The new Exhibition at the **Documentation Center** which reopened May 26.

The **Zeppelin Tribune** and **Zeppelfeld** will become a learning and encounter site, with historic spaces accessible to the public for the first time.

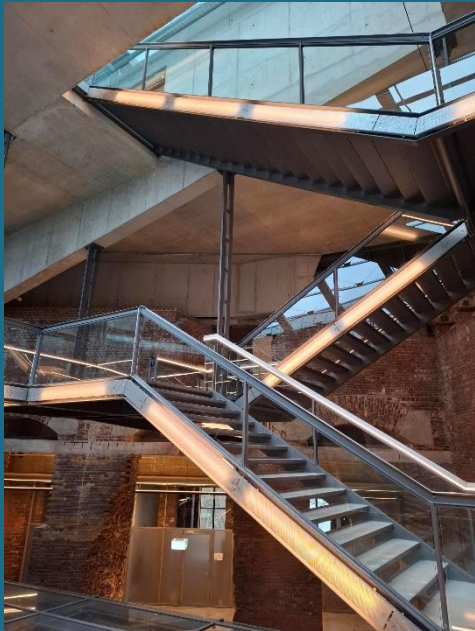
At the **Congress Hall**, new rehearsal and performance spaces for art and culture will open.

And from Sept 2028, the State Theatre Nuremberg will perform in a **new concert hall** built inside the historic structure. Together, these projects transform a site once used for propaganda into a space for dialogue, reflection, and creativity.



New exhibition Documentation Center

- New narrative: based on the historical site of Nuremberg and the Nazi Party Rally Grounds, the history of National Socialism is told through objects and biographies
- New research: war, forced labor, camp structures and deportations on the Grounds





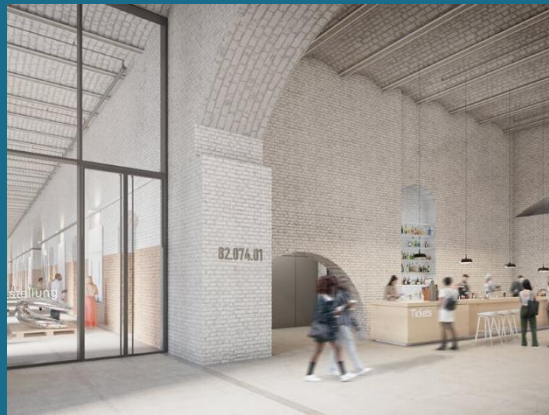
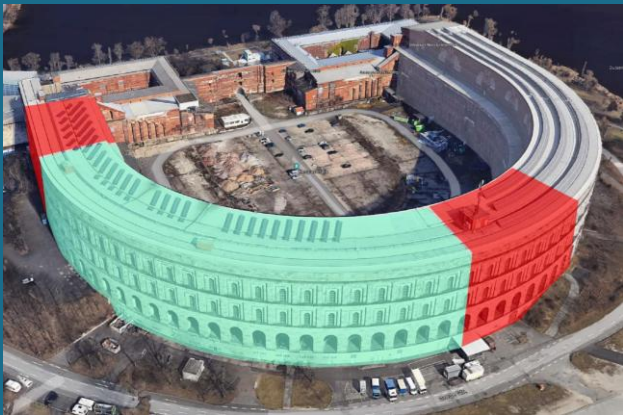
Zeppelin Tribune and Zeppelin Field

- Development into a **learning & encounter site**
future access to tribune interior, upper gallery & “Golden Hall”
- New exhibitions on architecture, Nazi propaganda, post-1945 use, and critical debates
- The indoor area with the exhibition will open at 2028
- The Zeppelin Field will be open to visitors starting in 2030



Congress Hall

- 7,000 square meters will be developed as rehearsal, performance and meeting spaces for all artistic disciplines
- Various exhibition and event spaces for artists from various disciplines with a curated, internationally relevant programme
- new home for State Theatre Nuremberg during opera renovation (from 2028)



NUREMBERG – Movie

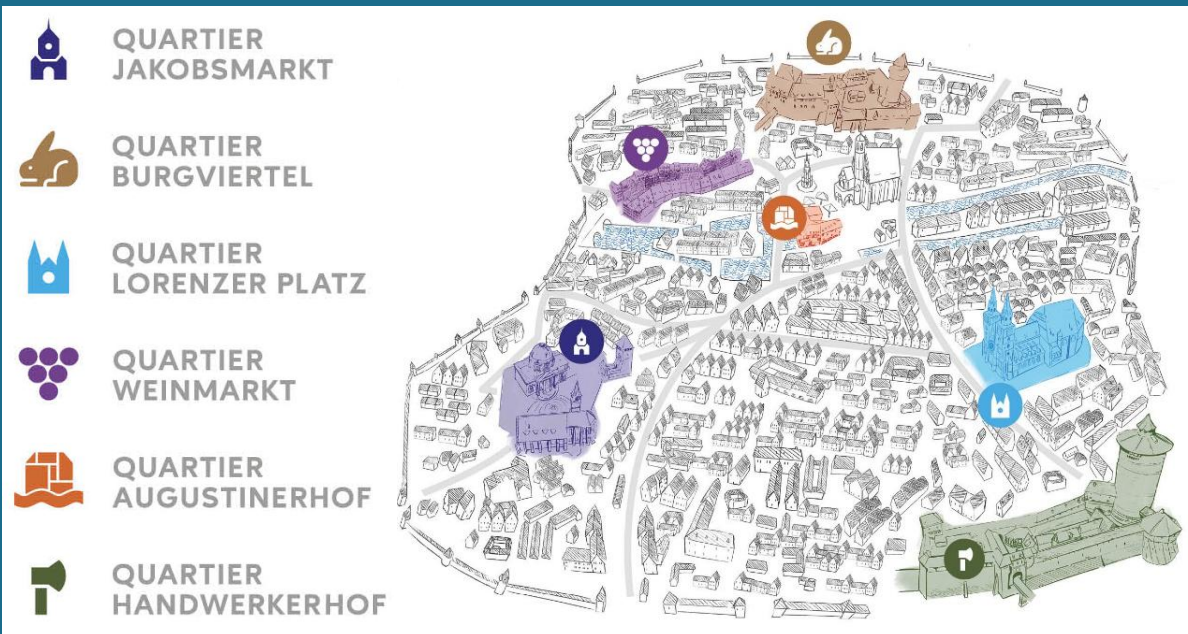
