Families Very Welcome In Nuremberg

Nuremberg is a charming city, and people of all generations feel good here. The Bündnis für Familie (Alliance for Families) which is supported by many social groups makes sure that in future, Nuremberg will be even friendlier towards families. Apart from relatively low living costs – compared with the rest of Germany –, the expansion of Nuremberg's child care institutions during the past few years contributed to Nuremberg being an attractive city for families. Present demographic development means that at the moment the percentage of senior citizens is increasing. Numerous institutions and organisations in the city cater for older people, facilitating their participation in the city's social, cultural and political life.

There is also excellent provision in the field of nursing care, whether it be in special nursing homes or in hospitals. With its Klinikum Nürnberg (Nuremberg Municipal Hospital), a hospital with more than 2,300 beds, the city owns a hospital which guarantees people from Nuremberg and the surrounding region the best possible care and treatment. In addition, there are 15 further hospitals with an overall number of more than 1,400 beds.

In Nuremberg, there is a major emphasis on voluntary work. Culture, the churches, sports or social services – these are only some of the many areas where Nuremberg's citizens make their valuable voluntary contributions. The "Zentrum Aktiver Bürger" (Centre for Active Citizens) was established to match willing citizens with the right voluntary work.
