Protecting the interests of Nuremberg is the responsibility of the City Council and the city administration, both of which are managed by the Lord Mayor. In accordance with the Bavarian Municipal Code, the City Council has 70 members. In the legislative period from May 1, 2014 to April 30, 2020 (based on the results of the local election of March 16, 2014), the SPD is the strongest parliamentary group with 31 seats. The CSU has 21 seats; the Greens have six. The Linke Liste has three members in the Nuremberg City Council, and the ÖDP, Freie Wähler and BIA each have two representatives. The FDP, Die Guten and the Piraten have one seat each in the council.

Dr. Ulrich Maly (SPD) is Lord Mayor. His deputies are the 2nd Mayor Christian Vogel (SPD) and the 3rd Mayor Dr. Klemens Gsell (CSU).
