For three decades, Rock im Park has been synonymous with an extraordinary festival experience in the heart of Nuremberg. As the sister festival of Rock am Ring, it brings international rock stars to the stage every year. Its unique location on the Zeppelin Field in Nuremberg combines a historic backdrop with urban flair and plenty of green space. Three days of music, short distances, and a genuine festival atmosphere make Rock im Park a special getaway.

Story

- Launched in the early 1990s as the southern counterpart and sister festival to Rock am Ring
- First stops under different names: 1993 in Vienna as "Rock in Vienna," 1994 in Munich as "Rock in Riem"
- From 1995-96 at Munich's Olympic Stadium as "Rock im Park"
- Rock im Park has been held in Nuremberg since 1997
- Change of main stage from Frankenstadion to Zeppelinfeld
- Cult status: steadily increasing visitor numbers and regularly sold out

- In 2025, Rock im Park celebrated its 30th anniversary
- The Zeppelin Field and Tribune were originally built for the Nazi Party Rallies.
- Camping directly on the grounds or comfortably in a hotel – both options are possible
- Due to excellent public transport connections, the festival grounds can be reached quickly and easily from the city center
